ANUAL REPORT

From January 1st 1977 to December 31st 1977 a total of 986 Complaints was reported with 147 of these being unfounded leaving a total of 839 actual crimes reported in 1977. A total of 96 of these was cleared or 11.4 % of all actual crime reported. For the same period of 1976 a total of 1020 complaints was reported with 222 of these being unfounded leaving a total of 798 actual crimes with a total cleared of 139 or 17.4 %. This shows a 6% decrease in crimes cleared in 1977 as to 1976.

Below is a chart of Actual crimes reported in the class 1 group for 1977 as compared to 1976.

All other crimes or class # 2 actual crimes reported was 348 in 1977 as to 316 in 1976, or 10.8 % increase in 1977.

In 1976 22.8% of all crime cleared involved persons under the age of 18 yrs. In 1977 &% of all crimes cleared involved persons under the age of 18 Yrs.

The Total arrests for 1977 was 470 as to 466 in 1976 an increase of 4 or less then 1 %.

The total traffic Accidents in 1977 was 314 with one of these being a fatal. In 1976 322 traffic accidents was investigated with 1 of these a Fatal making 8 less traffic accidents investigated in 1977 then in 1976.

In 1977 28,091 Telephone calls was recorded as to 31,174 in 1976, a decrease of 3,083 or 8.8% in 1977, Radio calls in 1977 was 34,537 as to 37,932 in 1976 a decrease of 3,375 or 8.8% in 1977 In 1977 1,231 Fire calls was received as to 1,071 in 1976 an increase of 160 or 14.9% calls in 1977, In 1977 2007 Watt's calls was rec. as to 2,031 in 1976 a decrease of 24 or 1.1% in 1977.

An average total of 7.80 calls per hour was handled by the dispatchers or 1 call every eight minutes, A total of 9,576 T.T. Msgs. was sent in 1977 this being a total of 26.23 sent per day or 8.72 sent per shift or 1.09 sent per hour.
