

1978 WASHINGTON COUNTY SHERIFF
ANUAL REPORT

From January 1 st 1978 to December 31 st 1978 a total of 1108 Complaints was reported with 163 of these being unfounded leaving a total of 945 actual crimes reported in 1978. A total of 184 of these was cleared or 19.4% of all crimes reported. For the same Period of 1977 a total of 986 complaints was reported with 147 of these being unfounded leaving a total of 839 actual crimes with a total cleared of 96 or 11.4%. This shows a increase of 8% of crimes cleared in 1978 over 1977.

All other crimes of class # 2 actual crimes reported was 389, also reported was 72 class # 2 crimes that was unfounded 72 of the Class #2 crimes was cleared in 1978 or a total of 23.3%

In 1977 316 actual class #2 crimes reported with a total of 53 cleared or 16.7% cleared in 1977.

In 1977 7% of all crimes cleared involved Juveniles under the age of 18 yrs. in 1978 34.9% of all crimes cleared involved Juveniles under the age of 18 yrs.

The Total arrests for 1978 was 424 as to 470 in 1977 a decrease of 46.

In 1978 129 Traffic arrests was made as to 223 in 1977 a decrease of 94 or a 42 % decrease in traffic arrests in 1978. In 1978 39 drunk drivers was arrested as to 60 in 1977 a decrease of 21 or 35 % drunk drivers was arrested in 1978 then in 1977. 26 Mentals was transported to Athens in 1978 as to 13 in 1977 an increase of 13 or 100 % in 1978. In 1978 a total of 232 Crim. arrests was made and in 1977 232 Criminal arrests was made.

The total number of Prisoners held in the Washington county Jail in 1978 was 2115 as to 1839 in 1977 an increase of 276 or 15.1 % in 1978 of these in 1978 1838 were male prisoner over 18, 178 were female prisoners over 18 108 males under 18 and 16 females under 18, an increase of 263 adult males in 1978 or 16.7% an increase of 55 adult females in 1978 or 44 %, A decrease of 13 males under 18 or a 10 % decrease, an increase of 3 females under 18 or a 23 % increase.

In 1978 a total of 10 cars and 1 van was in operation with a total of 212,424 miles being driven in the cars only, with a total of 23329.1 Gal of gas used for a total Cost of 14,890.81. Oil purchased on credit cards was 48 Qts. at a cost of \$60.06. A total of 252 Qts was taken from the Office and used in the Vehicles, There was a decrease of 54,774 miles traveled in 1978 as to 1977 with a decrease of 2,304.49 dollars spent for gas in 1978, In 1978 one car a 1973 Chev. was taken out of Svc. in June and a 1975 Ford was taken out of Svc in OCT.

The total traffic Accidents in 1978 was 253 with 2 of these being Fatals. In 1977 314 Traffic accidents was investigated with 1 being a fatal making a total of 61 less traffic accidents handled in 1978 then in 1977.

in 1978 30,804 Telephone call's was Recorded as to 28,091 in 1977 an increase of 2,117 or 7.5 % . Radio calls in 1978 was 29,500 in 1978 as to 34,537 in 1977 a decrease of 5,037 or 14.5 % in 1978..In 1978 867 Fire cass was Rec. as to 1,231 in 1977 a decrease of 364 or 29.5 % in 1978. In 1978 2,253 calls was Rec. on the Wats line as to 2007 in 1977 an increase of 246 or 12.2% in 1978.

An average total of 7.2 calls per hour was handled by the dispatchers or 1 call every 8.3 minutes, Total number of t.T Sent in 1978 Sent per day sent per shift.
