

1979 WASHINGTON COUNTY SHERIFF
ANNUAL REPORT

From January 1st 1979 to December 31st 1979 a total of 1,439 complaints were called into the Washington County Sheriff Department with a total of 125 of these being unfounded, leaving a total of 1,314 complaints to be investigated and handled. A total of 229 of these crimes reported were cleared or a total of 17.4% cleared. In 1978 a total of 1,108 crimes were reported with 163 being unfounded and a total of 184 cleared or a total of 19.4% cleared. This shows a decrease of 2% of crimes cleared in 1979 as to 1978.

A total of 836 Class #1 Crimes were reported with 43 of these being unfounded.

A total of 603 Class #2 Crimes were reported with 82 of these being unfounded.

In 1979 45.5% of all crimes cleared was involving persons under the age of 18 or 56 out of 123 crimes cleared. In 1978 34.9% of all crimes cleared involved juveniles under the age of 18 years. An increase in 1979 of 10.6%.

The total arrests for 1979 was 502 as to 424 in 1978, an increase of 78. In 1979 183 traffic arrests were made as to 129 in 1978 an increase of 54. In 1979 34 drunk drivers were arrested as to 39 in 1978, a decrease of 5, 23 mentals were transported to Athens. In 1979 195 Criminal arrests were made as to 232 in 1978, a decrease of 37 arrestes in 1979 as to 1978.

In 1979 45.5% of all crimes cleared was involving persons under the age of 18 or 56 out of 123 crimes cleared. In 1978 34.9% of all crimes cleared involved juveniles under the age of 18 years. An increase in 1979 of 10.6%.

The total arrests for 1979 was 502 as to 424 in 1978, an increase of 78. In 1979 183 traffic arrests were made as to 129 in 1978 an increase of 54. In 1979 34 drunk drivers were arrested as to 39 in 1978, a decrease of 5, 23 mentals were transported to Athens. In 1979 195 Criminal arrests were made as to 232 in 1978, a decrease of 37 arrestes in 1979 as to 1978.
