

1980 WASHINGTON COUNTY SHERIFF

ANNUAL REPORT

From January 1st 1980 to December 31 1980 a total of 1712 complaints was called into the Washington County Sheriff Department with a total of 211 of these being unfounded, leaving a total of 1501 complaints to be investigated and handled. A total of 257 of these crimes were cleared or a total of 17.1%. In 1979 a total of 1439 crimes was reported with 125 of these being unfounded and a total of 229 of these was reported cleared or 17.4% cleared this shows a decrease of .2% crimes cleared in 1980 as to 1979

A total of 947 Class # 1 Crimes was reported with 72 of these being Unfounded.

A total of 765 Class # 2 Crimes was reported with 139 of these being Unfounded.

In 1980 10.2% of all crimes cleared was involving persons under the age of 18 only or 25 out of the 257 crimes cleared

In 1979 45.5% of all crimes cleared was involving persons under the age of 18 years. A decrease of 35.3%

The total arrests for 1980 was 552 as to 502 in 1979, an increase of 50 in 1980.

107-Traffic arrests was made as to 183 in 1979 a decrease of 76

In 1980 33 drunk drivers was arrested as to 34 in 1979 a decrease of 1

In 1980 269 Criminal arrests was made as to 262 in 1979 an increase of 7 in 1980
