

1980 WASHINGTON COUNTY SHERIFF
ANNUAL REPORT

From January 1st 1981 to December 31 st 1981 a total of 1527 complaints was called into the Washington County Sheriff's Department with a total of 135 of these being unfounded, leaving a total of 1394 actual complaints to be investigated and handled. A total of 266 of these complaints were cleared or a total of 19%.

In 1980 a total of 1712 complaints was reported with 211 of these being unfounded and a total of 257 of these crimes were reported cleared or a total of 17.1% cleared this shows an increase of 2% crimes cleared in 1981 as to 1980

A total of 856 Class #1 crimes was reported with 51 of these being unfounded. A total of 671 Class #2 crimes was reported with 84 of these being unfounded. In 1981 8.6% of all crimes cleared involved persons under the age of 18 years or 23 out of 266 crimes cleared.

In 1980 10.2% of all crimes cleared was involving persons under the age of 18 years A decrease of 1.6% in 1981 as to 1980.

The total arrests for 1981 was 665 as to 552 in 1980 an increase of 152 in 81
