ANNUAL REPORT

From Jan. 1st 1982 to Dec. 31 st 1982 A totalof 1307 Complaints was reported to the Washington County Sheriff's Department. With a total of 153 of these being unfounded leaving a total of 1154 complaints to be handled and investigated. Out of this total 300 of these complaints was for report only leaving a total of 854 complaints for units to work on. Of these 285 of these complaints was cleared or a total of 33 % cleared.

In 1981 a total of 1527 complaints was reported with 135 of these being unfounded 266 crimes or complaints was cleared or a total of 19 % This shows an increase of 14 % of crimes cleared in 1982 as to 1981.

A total of 690 Class # 1 crimes was reported with 59 of these being unfounded. A total of 617 class # 2 crimes was reported with 94 of these being unfounded.

In 1982 14% of all crimes cleared involved persons under the age of 18 yrs. In 1981 8.6% of all crimes cleared involved persons under the age of 18, an increase of 5.4% in 1982 over 1981.

The total arrests for 1982 was 620 as to 665 in 1981.
